Dear Valued Customer:

At present, the Coronavirus (COVID-19) has not impacted the day-to-day operations of HDT Expeditionary Systems, Inc. We are rapidly updating and implementing our contingency plan to address the potential that one or more of our production facilities are affected.

In order to protect its workforce, an HDT team, consisting of operations, human resources, information technology and legal is monitoring the situation hourly. HDT is following, and has instructed employees to follow, the Interim Guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Employees are instructed that the Interim Guidance applies both at work and outside of work.

HDT has suspended all travel outside the continental United States, and all continental travel, except where absolutely critical, such as for purposes of fulfilling our contractual obligations.

HDT is closely monitoring its supply chain to prevent the potential disruptions of critical supplies and services.

All of HDT's suppliers have been alerted to notify HDT of any potential shortage or other impact to operations that might affect its shipping and HDT production. HDT has asked its suppliers to implement similar practices as HDT has implemented in order to attempt to minimize interference with the supply chain.
